Section 508 is a part of the U.S. Rehabilitation Act of 1973 requiring that electronic and information technology developed, procured, maintained, or used by the federal government be accessible to people with disabilities. Section 508 was added to the Rehabilitation Act in 1986, and further amendments in 1998 significantly expanded and strengthened its technology access requirements. The Workforce Investment Act of 1998 includes the Rehabilitation Act amendments of 1998.

Netezza supports Section 508 and the efforts of the federal government in making technology accessible to people with disabilities. Netezza, by virtue of this site, is committed to assisting its government customers in complying with Section 508.

The Netezza Performance Server® (NPS®) is a terascale, purpose-built data warehouse appliance that resides in a data center facility with specific power and cooling requirements.

The NPS systems offers remote configuration and monitoring by use of command-line interface (CLI), which is inherently accessible, and also provide context-sensitive online help for users. CLI-based applications are fully accessible to screen-reader technology and keyboard use without a mouse. These CLI-based applications conform to Section 508. Additional administrative access is provided via a standard web interface accessibly by standards based browser software.
